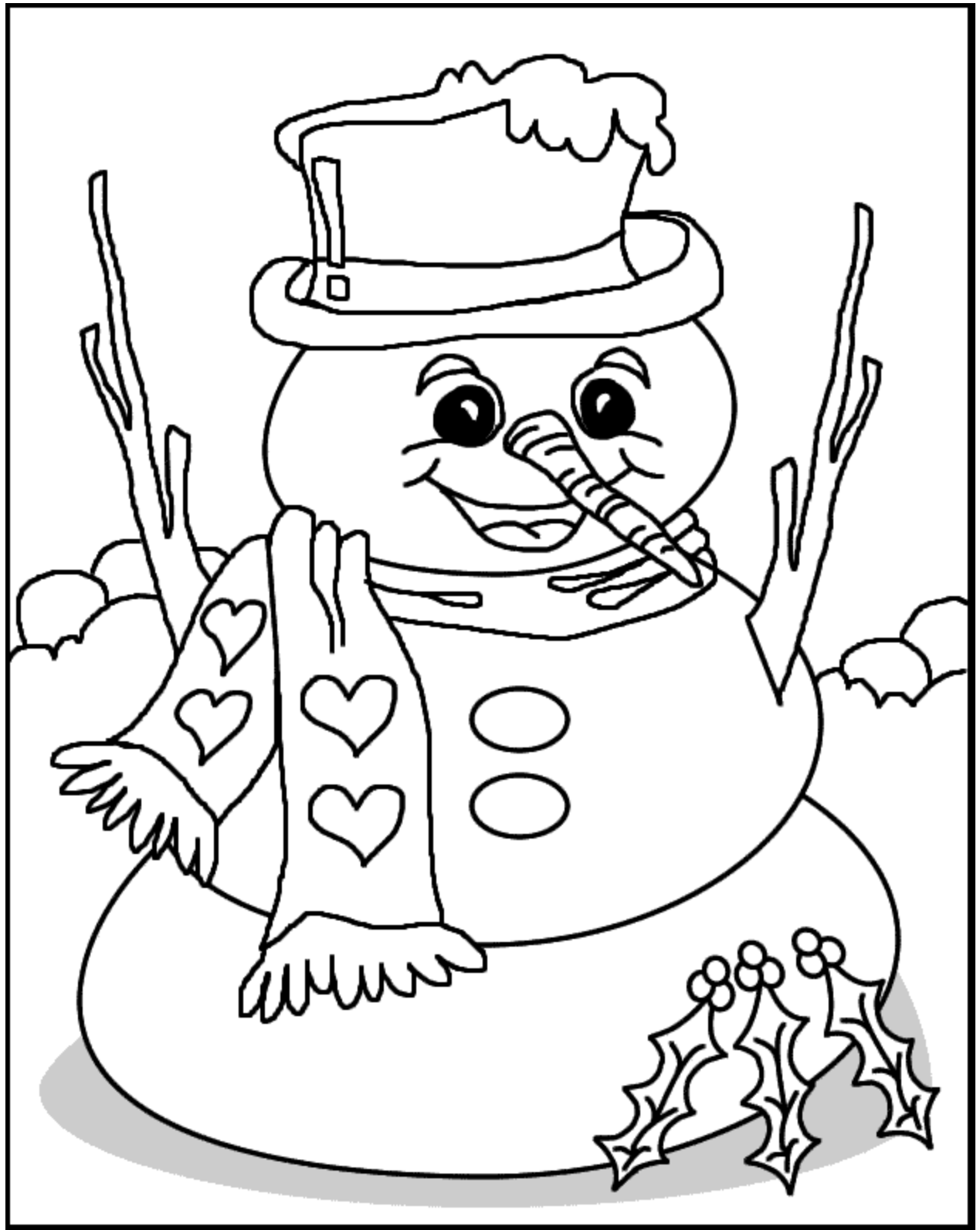



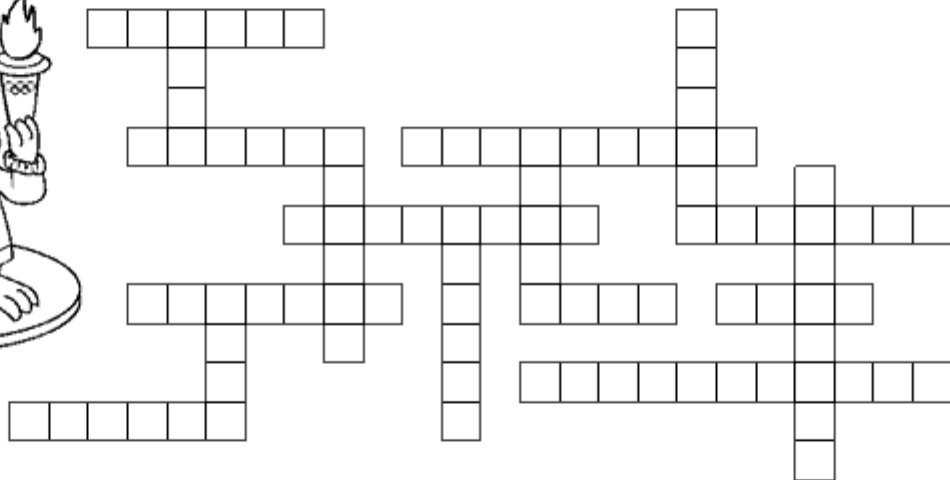
Which present is different from the rest?
